GENERAL MEETING INFORMATION

The American Society of Animal Science (ASAS), the American Dairy Science Association® (ADSA®), the Western Section of the American Society of Animal Science (WSASAS) and the Canadian Society of Animal Science (CSAS) will hold the 2016 Joint Annual Meeting (JAM) in Salt Lake City, Utah, July 19–23.

In addition to our JAM hosts, we are excited to welcome the 5th Grazing Livestock Nutrition Conference (GLNC) before JAM 2016 on July 17-19 and the International Society for Animal Genetics (ISAG) after JAM 2016 on July 23-27. JAM, combined with these two conferences, will create the most comprehensive two weeks of animal science meetings in history. Schedule of Events

The 2016 ASAS-ADSA-WSASAS-CSAS JAM will be held July 19–23 (Tuesday through Saturday). The opening session will be Tuesday evening, July 19; scientific sessions will begin Wednesday morning, July 20, and run through noon on Saturday, July 23.

As a reminder, GLNC will take place July 17-19 and ISAG will be July 23-27.

Please note the pattern shift for JAM, with the opening being Tuesday, July 19.

Location

The meeting will be held at the Salt Palace Convention Center and area hotels. The convention center is ideally located within walking distance of hotels, shopping and dining. GLNC will take place at the Canyons Resort - Park City and ISAG will take place at the Hilton Salt Lake City Center.

PRESENTATION INFORMATION

Notice to Presenters

If an abstract is accepted, a presenter must attend the meeting to present (this applies to both oral and poster presentations).

If a nonmember presenter (i.e., not a member of ASAS, ADSA, WSASAS or CSAS) is not registered for the 2016 Joint Annual Meeting by 11:59 pm (Central time) on April 5, 2016, their abstract will not be published. It will be removed from the program and will no longer be available for presentation at the meeting. Nonmembers who register but cannot attend the meeting and are unable to arrange for a substitute presenter will receive a 90% refund, provided the reason for nonattendance is a personal emergency. If nonattendance is due to visa denial, a 50% refund will be made. All nonmember presenter requests for refunds must be accompanied by appropriate documentation and will be processed after the meeting in the form in which registration payment was made (e.g., if you paid by credit card, the refund will be applied to your credit card account). If you are presenting a poster, please note that because posters are electronic, you will be required to upload your poster even if you cannot attend. Because posters must be presented, no refunds will be given for poster presenters who do not attend the meetings.

Oral and Invited Speakers

Oral sessions will begin at 9:30 am on Wednesday and Thursday, 10:30 am on Friday, and 8:30 am on Saturday. Meeting rooms will be equipped for electronic presentations and pre-loaded sessions.

Upload Information

Pre-meeting upload:

Presenters will be able to upload presentation files in advance of the meeting. Avoid the onsite rush and upload your presentation on your own schedule. The upload website will available 24 hours a day starting May 2, 2016 thru July 14, 2016 via the meeting website. Files will not be accepted via e-mail.

Onsite upload:

Onsite presentation upload will be available; files can be delivered to the Pre-Load Room at the convention center. Presentations must be uploaded by 5:00 pm on the day before your scheduled presentation. Files will not be accepted via e-mail. No presentations will be loaded while the session is in progress or between presentations.

Poster Presentations

We have dedicated 4 one-hour blocks each day on Wednesday – Friday and 2 one-hour blocks on Saturday for poster presentations. The "open poster" sessions will be from 7:15 to 8:15 am Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. Each poster presentation will be available for public viewing for the entire day, with the presenting authors present during the open posters time (7:15–8:15 am). The poster presentations space will be located in the Exhibit Hall. We are bringing ePosters to JAM in 2016. All posters will be presented as ePosters. This new format offers some new and exciting options for poster presenters and attendees. Most notably, all posters will be on display for the duration of the meeting and available to all attendees to view at their leisure. This new technology is less expensive for presenters than printed posters and is easily transportable.

Some features of the ePosters include:

- Posters are no longer constrained to a single page; ePosters offer the option to have multiple pages per poster.
- Videos, animations, graphs and images can be embedded into the poster.
- Graphs and images can be expanded to full screen view with a single click, allowing for a more detailed presentation.

The exhibit hall will open at 6:30 am, Wednesday through Friday.

Notice to Attendees

Use of cameras, video cameras, and cell phones (for calls or as cameras) is prohibited during oral and poster presentations to minimize disruption and unauthorized dissemination of data. Anyone found in violation of this policy will be asked to leave the session.




