ASAS Travel Scholarship, provided by the Legacy Fund:

The Legacy Scholarship - Travel Award

Name of Award: The Legacy Scholarship - Travel Award

(available for applications during the 2025-2026 award season, and the first scholarships will be awarded at the <u>2026</u> ASAS Annual Meeting)

Nature of Award: A certificate and a specified monetary award towards expenses for travel to an ASAS meeting or training of the recipient's choice.

Purpose: To aid in the professional development and success of young animal scientists to attend an ASAS meeting or training, to be used within twelve months of receiving the award.

Eligibility for Nomination:

- ASAS membership for at least 12 months.
- Applicant must be a current graduate student member of ASAS.
- Applicants must submit an abstract for oral presentation at an ASAS meeting.
- Abstracts found unacceptable, as described in the ASAS "Quality Standards for Abstracts," will not be considered.
- Applications submitted for other ASAS student travel scholarships for the same meeting are not eligible for the Legacy Scholarship.
- Previous winners are not eligible.
- All entries must be submitted electronically by the published abstract deadline. Applicants who have not completed the abstract submission will be removed from consideration for the award.

Nomination dossier must contain the following:

- A description of the meeting or training opportunity (not to exceed 2670 characters and spaces).
- A justification of the importance of the opportunity (not to exceed 2250 characters and spaces).
- A budget and listing of matching funds.
- Confirmation of applicant's membership (ASAS Member ID Number).
- CV of applicant.
- Three letters of support from any ASAS members.
- Citation for printing and reading (not to exceed 1000 characters and spaces).

• Photo of nominee (photo will only be used in the awards program and will not be visible to the award review committee).
