ASAS Graduate Student Competition: MS Division

Students must be enrolled in a Master of Science Program at an accredited university at the time of abstract submission. Participating students or their advisor must be a current ASAS member. Competition abstract submissions are restricted to **ONE** per student.

Participating students must be listed as the presenting author and substitutions are not allowed. In the event that a student is unable to present his/her abstract and a presenting author substitution is required, the abstract will be presented in a general session. ASAS retains the right to move abstracts out of a competition and into a general session.

Abstracts of students for e-posters and oral presentations must be submitted by November 8, 2017 Student's e-posters must be submitted by February 12, 2018 or their abstract will be withdrawn from the competition.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in both e-poster and oral competition will be awarded \$300, \$200 and \$100, respectively.
